ROMPER ROOM

For your convenience we will be providing a supervised child's play area. This will include moon walks, crafts, tumbling mats, games, and more. This is designed for children ages 5-12 yrs. Arm bands are \$5 and kids can come and go as they please throughout the day. Children under age of 5 need adult supervision. Even though we do have qualified supervision in this room, it is important to know that this is not a daycare service. We will do our best to make sure kids don't wander, but if you will be leaving your child unsupervised, please know we are not responsible once they leave the room.

VENDORS

We have brought in several vendors for your convenience. There is no obligation to purchase anything, but they will be available.

EVENT SCHEDULE

We will do our best to provide a schedule of events one week prior to the competition.

TEAM REGISTRATION

Team registration will begin at 9:00 a.m. At this time we will make sure all forms have been turned in, provide any updated information, hand out t-shirts, and provide a facility tour for your coaches. We recommend sending in all shirt sizes and medical release forms prior to the competition. This will make for a smoother process. Coaches arm bands will be available at check in. 2 coaches per team will get in free.

WARM-UP AREA

Along with your event schedule, you will be given a warm-up time. Please report to the warm-up area about 10 minutes prior to your warm-up time. Once you go through warm-up you will be directed to the competition area. We recommend leaving any personal items with parents at this time. Only coaches and participants will be allowed in the warm-up area.

COMPETITION

We strive to run a very organized (on time) event. In order for us to do that we ask for everyone's support by abiding all competition schedules. We will provide a few breaks throughout the day to ensure we are on time. During these mini breaks, we will provide entertainment with fun contests. AWARDS

We will have two award ceremonies throughout the day. They will be broken down into All-Star and Individual. All-Star teams will receive a team placement trophy for their division, with division winners winning individual medals. We will also be rewarding the overall Junior and Senior High Point winner, plus choreography, and technique awards. Individual events will receive placement trophies.

Cash Prizes—Junior and senior best cheerleader and dancer will receive a \$50 cash prize. Junior is considered 6th grade and under and Senior is 7th-12th. The Top Gym will win a \$500 cash prize. We will take each gym's top 3 scores to determine the winner. There must be a minimum of 7 entries per junior and senior individual divisions to reward cash prizes. There must be a minimum of 10 teams (not gyms) to award top gym cash prize.
